Additional requirements for admission to a university in Washington State:

- Two years of the same World Language (three recommended)
- Take a math or math-based quantitative course during senior year
 - Quantitative courses: one of the three required math courses, an algebra-based science (Chemistry or Physics), or AP Computer Science.
EXCEPTION: Completion of Pre-Calculus prior to senior year also fulfills the senior year quantitative course requirement.
- Students and families should contact universities to verify admission requirements.
